Mary Jane and Tony,

Here's yet another update on my three month mold nightmare.

No one has showed up yet to address the mold problem in my house. It continues to grow while I grow increasingly more distressed. There's visible mold throughout the basement and both toilets grow a moldy ring within 5 days of being scrubbed.

My allergist, who has treated me for 15 years, told me this week that I have developed a new mold allergy where I had none before. I'm taking medications to alleviate the headaches and respiratory problems. Mostly, I'm staying out of the
